2	BDU Shirts; shirt & pants should match (i.e. summer/winter) weight)

1	Blue/black web belt w/subdued open face buckle and subdued (black) tip (aka. "BDU Belt")	
1	BDU hat (USAF style) No other headgear options allowed.	
6	Pair boot socks	
2	Pair blousing bands (pants may be tucked instead)	
1	Pair plain, black combat, jungle, or jump boot; shined	
6	Black undershirts (t-shirts) - must be plain with no lettering/decoration and no pocket

MEDICATIONS

CAPR 160-2 Handling of Cadet Medications establishes CAP national policy and procedures for the handling of cadet medications during certain CAP activities. The document, can be found at:

All medications must be brought in original container and listed on your encampment form.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

Weapons, knives, cash in excess of \$20*, illegal drugs (prescription and non-prescription must be disclosed to health services - see CAPR 160-2), tobacco, alcohol, 'energy' drinks, **food, candy, gum**, electronic devices such as computers, iPod's and similar, cameras, video games etc., jewelry other than wrist watch and earring studs for females.

**This is primarily for security reasons.*

CELL PHONES

Cadets will not be permitted to use cell phones during the encampment. All cadets will be required to surrender their cell phones on arrival. In case of EMERGENCY ONLY, parents may call the Encampment Commander at (865-679-9929).

HOW TO PACK YOUR GEAR: Encampments require a significant amount of equipment be brought to the activity. The facilities that will be used are ideal for encampment and provide many exciting activities throughout the week.

1. Wardrobe and Drawers are in the dormitory rooms, bring a suit case or duffel bag but include hangars for hanging items.
2. Bring uniforms on the hangars pre-pressed and wrinkle free. Garment bags if available should be used. Don't pack your uniforms in your main suitcase/footlocker/etc.
3. Only pack what is on this list. If there is something you think needs to be brought but is not listed above, contact your flight sergeant or flight commander and ask the question. Do NOT bring something without permission.

Any items found that are not on the equipment list will be confiscated and placed in contraband. Be accountable for your own actions and DO NOT pack anything not authorized on this equipment list. Bringing of unauthorized items or failure to disclose is grounds for dismissal from encampment.
